<b>Description:</b>	<p>Installing/upgrading 6.00.06 from a CD, xconfig.sh script works correctly from the CD but the HD seems to get left behind.</p> <p>- correct nvidia driver isn't installed</p> <p>- /etc/X11/xorg.conf isn't quite right</p> <p>This may be due to the /etc/pacman.conf problems previously noted.</p> <p>As a result the FE doesn't start at boot time instead you see:</p> <pre>&lt;code&gt; Starting LinHES frontend Starting LinHES frontend Starting LinHES frontend Frontend is not able to start, disabling it. &lt;/code&gt;</pre>
