Basically, Apple appears to be blocking the download. An attempt to download a trailer results in a redirect and download of the index.html from Apple's trailer site.

I had to uninstall and re-install `mythappletrailers` before it worked. Upgrades from earlier versions did not work. I think it must have to do with the script used to write "Loading..." since I didn't see "Loading..." on the screen until I uninstalled and re-installed. Given that the general public doesn't need to upgrade from earlier versions of the package, I'll close this ticket.
